“On the Last Day, that Great Day of the Feast” -

Jews had a special water-drawing ceremony with messianic significance. Water drawn from the Pool of Siloam was poured out from a golden vessel in the temple at the time of morning sacrifice.

Prayers were made for good rainfall during the coming season. This ceremony commemorated 2 things: water from the smitten Rock in the wilderness (Ex 17.1-7) and the coming millennial reign of Messiah and the river of living water that flows from His throne (Ezek 47.1,9).

As the water was poured out, the people sang Isa 12.3 “With joy therefore shall ye draw water out of the wells of salvation.”

Sometime during this ceremony, Jesus startled the huge assembly with His loud cry: “If any man thirst, let him come unto me and drink. He that believes on Me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.” vv37-38
