The Passover ceremony:

- 1. The guests, reclining around the table, were served wine. After offering a blessing, they drank it. A towel was passed around and they washed their hands.
- 2. Bitter herbs, unleavened bread and charoseth (a special sauce that looked like mortar) were brought in.
- 3. The head of the family dipped some of the herbs into the charoseth, prayed and gave a small portion to each person.

- 4. The unleavened bread was handed out and the roasted lamb was brought in.
- 5. A second cup of wine was poured and the meaning of the feast was explained, beginning with the youngest asking "Why is this night different from all other nights?"
- 6. The guests sang the first part of Psalms 113-118, the Hallel, as the hymn of praise and offered prayer.
- 7. The unleavened bread and the herbs that had been dipped in the charoseth were eaten.
- 8. They drank a third cup of wine.
- 9. They drank a fourth cup of wine and sang the rest of the Hallel.
